Interim Instructions for Filing Form I-601 *Application for Waiver of Grounds of Inadmissibility* and Form I-212 *Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission into the United States after Deportation or Removal* in Athens

Individuals residing in Greece must submit these applications in-person Monday through Friday between 8:30 am and 12:00 noon with USCIS at window 3 in the embassy's consular section. An appointment is not required.

Please review the forms' instructions to ensure your packet is complete. A complete packet includes

- ✓ Signed and dated I-601 and if required, I-212
 - I-601 must indicate all qualifying relatives
 - I-601 must have checked boxes for all relevant inadmissibilities
- ✓ Signed and dated Form G-325A, *Biographic Information*
- ✓ Signed and dated Form G-28, *Notice of Entry of Appearance of Attorney or Accredited Representative*, if represented by an attorney
- ✓ Evidence of extreme hardship to your qualifying relative (see attached for examples)
- ✓ Police and court records, if applicable
- ✓ Rehabilitation and other reformation evidence, if applicable
- ✓ Fee of \$ 585.00 payable in cash or by credit card for each application.
